WAPLEY BUSHES WORKDAY SUNDAY 4 SEPTEMBER 10.00 AM

This workday will be our annual stream clearance where we hope to clear the central watercourse through the main woodland. This work is required to preserve the habitat of the rare local thin-spiked wood sedge. Everyone welcome - please wear walking or wellington boots and bring some gloves. Meet at the Shire Way entrance to the woodland, South Yate, 10.00am.

GRASS CUTTING ON PART OF COMMON TO BE CHANGED

The "long grass" area of Wapley Common – the part where the new orchard trees were planted recently – has normally been cut once a year. We're considering leaving most of it uncut for a couple of years to form a "thatch" as a habitat for voles and mice, which will hopefully attract owls to the woodland.

A path will still be cut – more or less on the line that people already walk – and the hedge will be flailed back in the autumn to stop it encroaching on the Common. The grass round each tree will also be cut.
